Method of Fixing & Schedule of Flags

1) <u>Method of fixing flags to the arches of crescent.</u>

A timber batten will be supported from the cornice at the top of the arches and wedged in place. No fixings to the building. Banners secured to railings at base with bungee cords.

2) Method of fixing for Flag Poles

No flagpoles on Broadwalk.

Fixing will be by bandit ties on foam to railings. No excavation of ground. Flagpoles are white anodised aluminium tapered poles with rotating banner arms to prevent impact of wind.

All flagpoles will be removed at the end of the period. As per pictures supplied with application.

The 8 flags will be located:

4 on railings adjacent to Pavilion gardens opposite Old Hall Hotel 4 on railings outside railway station (Northern Rail / Network Rail informed).

3) Method of Fixing required for Lighting Columns.

Single banner arm fixed using bandit straps with protection to lighting columns. Base of banner tethered to column with protected chain weight loop to avoid damage to paintwork.

35 flags will be located at:
