

Retention Category A:
Trees whose retention is most desirable. Vigorous healthy tree of good form, free from obvious faults and of significant amenity value

Retention Category B:
Trees whose retention is desirable. Trees which are in a moderate to good condition although some minor faults may require correction by surgery.

Retention Category C:
Trees whose condition is moderate to poor and usually require a significant amount of tree surgery or be located in an area not readily accessible to the public.
