I, Derek Marbeck of 11 Birchside Avenue, Glossop

wish to register my objection to the

planning application HPK/2015/0412.

1) The proposed development will destroy an area of wild green space between Glossop and Hadfield deemed important in all previous local plans.

2) The proposed access onto Dinting Lane is inheritantly dangerous for the following reasons:

a) Dinting Road is essentially a rural road.

b) At peak times used as a 'rat run' by traffic seeking to avoid queues in the centre of Glossop on the A57 trunk road.

c) In 2017 when the new comprehensive school is located in Hadfield, an enormous increase in pupils walking, riding and car journeys along Dinting Road, plus increased commuter traffic when Talbot Road, North Road and Old Glossop sites are used for yet more housing.
