

HERITAGE STATEMENT

THE SMITHY FOLD - Glossop

NATURE OF THE ASSET

The gatehouse was built mid C19 with C20 alteration. Ashlar gritstone with ashlar dressings and coursed millstone grit to sides and walls. Welsh slate roofs. Single story facade with 2 storey interior. Street front, both gatehouses has rusticated fascades arch topped with pediment supported on single end pilasters and plain frieze. Central doorways with cornice on brackets and plain tattered architraves. The lodge was previously used as a tourist information office but is now part of The Smith Fold public house List entry number 1384302

EXTENT OF THE ASSET

The building sites in the county of Derbyshire in the district of High Peak and is part of The Smithy Fold public house

THE PROPOSED WORKS

The two new signs to the building are for the purpose of denoting the presence of the public house which is set back from the main road, giving customers information about its location and services

IMPACT ON THE ASSET

The signs will be fitted with concealed fixing which have little impact on the building structure. and will not be illuminated

JUSTIFICATION

The signs are to advertise the buildings usage as a Bar and denote the entrance and facilities
The acces in nbot affected by the signage as they are either flat back to the wall or above head height
