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1. Introduction

This Design and Access Statement accompanies an application for Britannia Palace Hotel, Palace Road, Buxton, Derbyshire, SK17 6AG. The statement has been written to meet the requirements of article 4C of the Town and Country Planning (General Development Procedure) (Order 1995).

As this is an application for a minor amendment to an existing car park, some aspects such as the social and economic context are of limited applicability.

2. Context


The hotel is located just off Palace Road. The existing access to the site will remain unchanged: however change of usage will implicate additional control measures to the previous car park to accommodate a Car park management system.

The site accommodates 1.31 hectares of surface space and provides allocated parking provisions to 150 vehicles, there will also be 3 disabled bays. The Car Park will be altered to show parking bays, this will create a safer more accessible car park.

3. The Proposal

The purpose of the proposal is to this unused car park into a working car park that will provide sufficient parking for the area into a Car Park Management System via Automatic Number Plate Recognition. This car park is to utilise a ParkingEye Car Park Management System. The proposed works will be housed in the existing grounds of Britannia Palace Hotel, Palace Road, Buxton, Derbyshire, SK17 6AG.


The existing access and egress to the car park have not been altered therefore the visible aspect from the roadside still remains the same as its existing condition.


The relationship between the proposed works and the public routes will remain largely unaffected, as works should not impede on the on looking pavement or highway access.

<u>Automatic Number Plate Recognition Camera – Camera mounted on a new 6m high column</u>



In relation to the examples of the Car Park Management Systems at ParkingEye Limited, strict confidentiality is maintained at all times. We as a company can ensure that the residential privacy will not be affected and therefore shall be maintained with the utmost respect at all times whilst our car park management systems are in operation. We hope this information will explain to the consultees and neighbours of our ANPR camera systems and how our business works.

I can confirm that the cameras which we are proposing to install at Britannia Palace Hotel, Palace Road, Buxton, Derbyshire, SK17 6AG.are static and fixed to a single capture zone for access and egress purposes only. These ANPR cameras will not be pivoting in any rotational axis horizontally or vertically. ParkingEye cameras are not CCTV cameras and are Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) Cameras, therefore will only be checking the car park for offences as they pass through our capture zones, at the entrance and exit of the car park.

4. Access Issues

Car Parking

General public car park customers are advised to comply with the time limits which are to be outlined by the signage advertisement within the car park.

5. Summary

This Design and Access Statement proposes the conversion of Britannia Palace Hotel, Palace Road, Buxton, Derbyshire, SK17 6AG.into a Car Park Management system with Automatic Number Plate Recognition system (ANPR). The system installation will have minimal disruption to the surrounding buildings and businesses. Local access will not be affected; therefore entrance/exit will still be visible from the road and pavement.

The existing layout of the car park will not be altered in any way. All public access and pavements will remain intact, so there will be no impact on the public or organised walking parties. The ParkingEye Car Park Management System does not install CCTV systems. The ANPR cameras will only be reading number plates of cars entering and exiting the Britannia Palace Hotel, Palace Road, Buxton, Derbyshire, SK17 6AG., these cameras are in a fixed position at all times.

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
