- Evita Perennial Ryegrass 12.5%
 Sauvignon Perennial Ryegrass 12.5%
- Cezanne Slender Creeping Red Fescue 20%
 Leonora Slender Creeping Red Fescue 15%
 Musica Chewings Fescue 20%
- Conni Smooth Stalked Meadow Grass 10%
- Limousine Smooth Stalked Meadow Grass 10%

- Strong creeping red fescue 40%Smooth stalk meadow grass 10%
- chewings fescue 15%
- Slender creeping red fescue 10%
- Amenity perenbial ryegrass 15%
- Rough stalk meadow grass 5% • Wood meadow grass 5%

PLANTING AREAS MARKED A:

All Shrubs to be contaier grown 2li Pots: Choyisya Terrata (Mexican Orange) 3 pots per Sq m

Enoymus Fortuei 'Compactus' (Emerald & Gold) 4 pots per Sqm

Leucothoe fontanesana. (Rainbow) 3 pots per Sq m HEDGES TO REAR GARDENS:

All plants to be container grown and supplied min height 40-50cm

to be a mix of Prunus Laurocerasus (cherry Laurel) 3 pots per lin m

• Verburnum lantana (wayfering tree) 2 pots per Lin m

- Photinia x fraseri (Fraser-Red Robin) 2 pots per Lin m
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ilex aqifolium(Holly) 1 pot per Lin
 FLOWERBEDS TO REAR GARDENS AND FRONT GARDEN AREAS:

these areas will be left un planted but will recive a min of 300mm topsoil prepared and ready for the occupiers to plant flowering plants of there choice.

PAVED AREAS:

Buff coloured riven faced concrete paveing slabs laid to falls on full motor bed on compacted hardcore.

with matching edgeings to finish flush with paved surface. decorative gravel to be Offerton sand and gravel goldcoast or simular with Buf colored 150mmx50mm conrete edgeing. TOP SOIL:

New Flowerbeds to have a Min 300mm good qualitytopsoil new lawned areas to have a min 100mm topsoil.
