**Development HPK/2014/0119 Houses off Linglongs Road, Whaley Bridge.**

We would like to object to the above mentioned development on the following grounds:-

- I object to filling in the land between Taxal and Macclesfield Road.
- The land is a valuable wildlife site which is crossed by The Midshires Way and is part of the Gateway to the Goyt – access to the beautiful Goyt Valley.
- The visual impact from the surrounding countryside will be immense.
- The access onto Macclesfield Road will be a disaster since Macclesfield Road feeds into the traffic lights at Horwich End which is a major “bottleneck” especially at peak times. It frequently backs up as far back as the Cheshire border.
- I object to increased traffic on the dangerous junction of Linglongs Road and Macclesfield Road.
- I object to the loss of Owl and Bat habitat and the loss of ecology and wildlife flora and fauna.
- I object to the increased noise and light pollution into our environment.
- Our small town will struggle to cope with this big development. The schools are already full and the Doctors' and Dentists are extremely busy.
- Macclesfield Road is quite narrow in places and extremely difficult to cross for pedestrians with present volumes of traffic. Some stretches only have footpath on one side of the road.
