Dear All,

Thank you for responding to the original Gladman Application HPK/2014/0119. This has now been revised due to Highway and Access concerns. The revision includes an additional vehicle and pedestrian access point (vehicle IN only i.e One-Way traffic) between 84 and 90 Macclesfield Road (Not the Midshires Way). Access on Linglongs Road remains as previous. They propose to widen part of Linglongs Road to the junction with Linglongs Avenue and provide 2m footpaths to both sides. Although this improvement does not include the first section of Linglongs Road from the junction which will remain narrow with only one footpath.

Revised Gladman Planning Application Notices can now be seen on local lamp posts and we have calculated that any responses from the Public must be made by the very latest 18th July 2014.

We would encourage you all to put pen to paper now!

To assist we attach a flyer highlighting our main concerns. We would prefer you to put your own comments in writing and email to jane.colley@highpeak.gov.uk

Alternatively, you may wish to forward the attached flyer.

At this stage, the number of responses do count, so if you have more than one member of the household with email, please encourage the others to also respond.

We would also encourage you to print the flyer and pass to your neighbours if you are not in the immediate vicinity of Macclesfield Road and request that any new respondents copy us in by email. The last campaign generated almost 100 new objectors! We hope this one will generate even more!
