Submission: Objection

Comments: To erect a white wedding marquee with up to 40 car parking spaces, porta-loos and additional land lighting in open countryside is incongruous, inappropriate and bordering on plain ludicrous.

1. The fact that this is a RETROSPECTIVE application, with the marquee having already been erected in August 2016, illustrates the ignorance and disrespect for the countryside by those responsible.
