How the Marquee will be put up and then removed. That isn't a permanent structure so even if planning permission were granted civil weddings couldn't be done there. The applicant must know this as I am sure they did their homework before making a planning application.

Then I read the website of the company providing the marquees and when read carefully they don't say they do civil marriages, they do the parties after a legal wedding has taken place elsewhere. That appears to have been well hidden or not disclosed in the planning application. It's a late night party venue not a wedding venue. To my mind planners should consider this application with that as a major consideration it's a late night party venue not a wedding venue!
