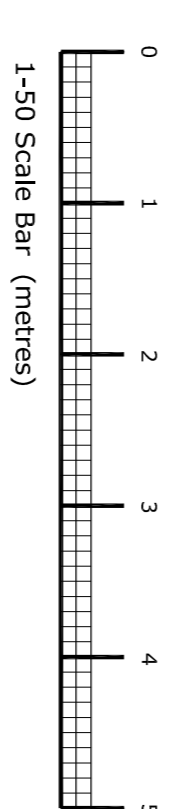

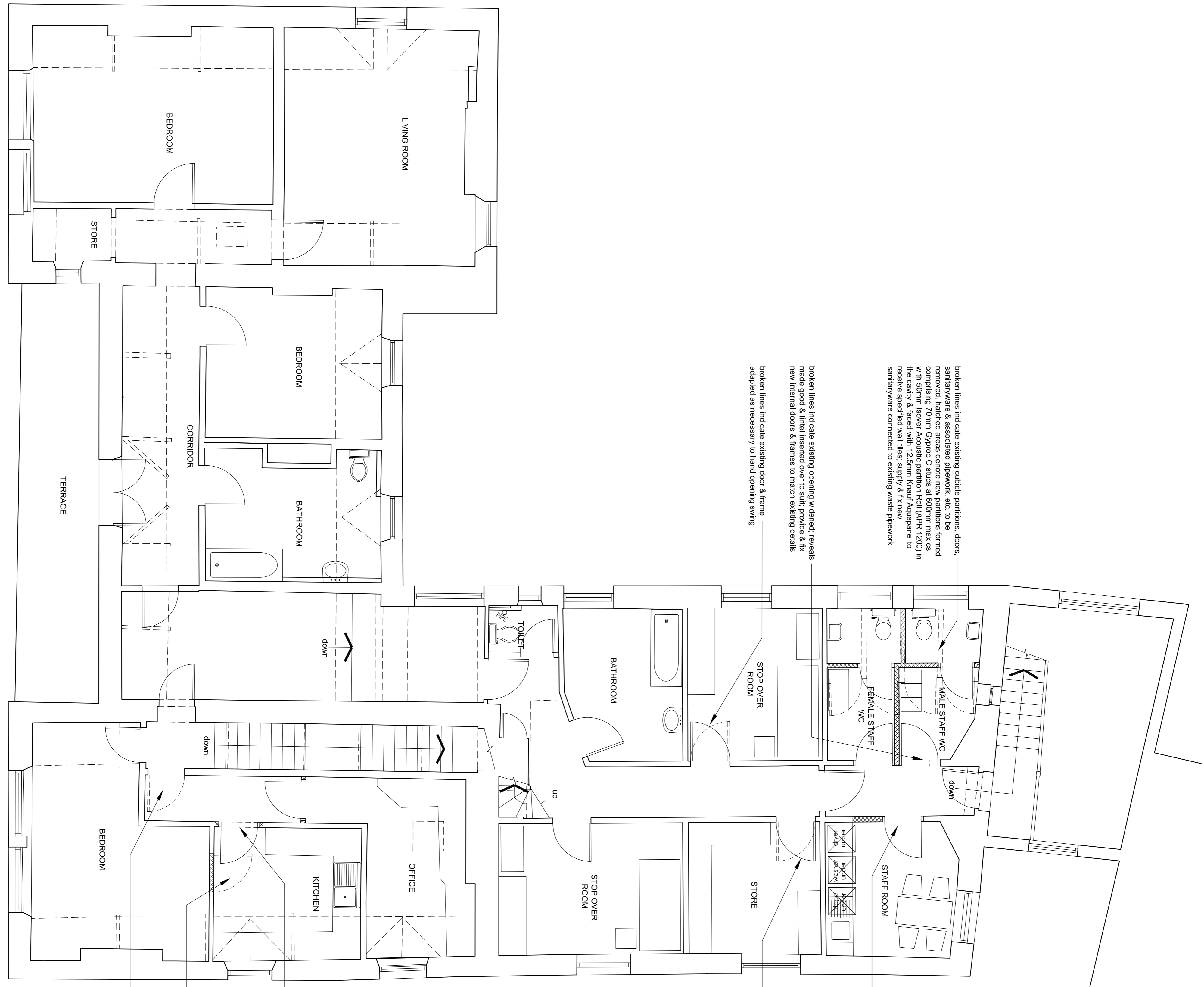

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broken lines indicate existing outside partitions, doors, sanitary ware, etc. to be removed; hatched areas denote new partitions formed comprising 70mm Gyproc C studs at 600mm max cs with 50mm Isover Acoustic partition Roll (APR 1200) in the cavity & faced with 12.5mm Krauf Aquapanel to receive specified wall tiles; supply & fit new sanitaryware connected to existing waste pipework

broken lines indicate existing opening widened; reveals made good & lintel inserted over to suit; provide & fit new internal doors & frames to match existing details

broken lines indicate existing door & frame adapted as necessary to hand opening swing

hatched area denotes existing opening partially built up with stud partition to suit existing wall thickness comprising 70mm Gyproc C studs at 600mm max cs with 50mm Isover Acoustic partition Roll (APR 1200) in the cavity & faced with 12.5mm plasterboard, scrim & painted skim finish both sides; supply & fit new internal door & frame to match existing details

broken lines indicate existing door & frame adapted as necessary to hand opening swing

broken lines indicate opening formed in existing wall; reveals made good & lintel inserted over to suit wall construction; provide & fit new internal door & frame to match existing

broken lines indicate existing door & frame removed; hatched area denotes opening built up level with adjacent existing surfaces

broken lines indicate existing door & frame removed & reveals made good prior to redecoration
