I would like to add 2 more comments about wildlife and the environment.

1. The existing building is supposedly an outstanding example of environmentally friendly design. However nothing has been said about the horrendous light pollution from the building which can be seen as far away as Axe Edge. It is unacceptable for any further building to emit more light pollution and Nestle should take steps to mitigate against the existing pollution.

2. This would be a great opportunity for Nestle to demonstrate its environmental support by having Swift/House Martin nest boxes on the existing and any new building. Nesting sites for these wonderful birds are being greatly reduced.

Where is HPBC's environmental policy? If there is one it surely must include plans for builders to include these issues in any application which have been introduced by several forward thinking Local Authorities.
