I am writing in response to the change in planning that means there is only one access road into the new proposed housing estate and the only access road is now Linglongs Road.

I live on Linglongs Ave and turn left onto Macclesfield road every morning, the builders proposal creates a serious risk to human life..

I have reported before, in writing, that this junction is dangerous when turning left or right out of Linglongs Road and turning right into Linglongs Road when traveling from Macclesfield.

The dangers of Turning Left or right out of Linglongs Road onto Macclesfield Road .

1. There is a bus stop at the junction that obscures the view and pedestrians waiting for the bus block the view and makes it dangerous to turn left..
2. There are always parked cars on Macclesfield road that make turning in and out of the junction dangerous
3. There are bushes in the gardens that block the view that means you have to edge out into the road to turn out of the junction that poses a risk to oncoming traffic and ourselves.
4. There is a Lime factory, the size of the tankers are too big for the road and when they are coming down the Hill it makes turning left treacherous.
5. Cars park at the entrance of linglongs road which means cars turning left or right into linglongs have to stop in the middle of the road posing a risk to other road users.

The dangers of Turning Right into Linglongs Road

1. The parked cars on Macclesfield road mean you have to move into the middle of the road to turn right blocking the oncoming traffic with significant risk of an accident.
2. Parked cars on linglongs road mean you can't actually make the turning and you are stuck blocking oncoming traffic.

The junction is presently dangerous and there is a constant high accident risk. With increased traffic this poses a risk to human life.

The junction needs to be widened .

The bus stop needs removing

Parking needs to be banned on linglongs road and Macclesfield road.

A turning junction needs to be built on Macclesfield road, this was in the original plans .

Linglongs Road is subsiding at the junction and along the first 100 metres of the road and increased developer traffic will lead to a collapse of the road. The road needs reinforcing

The builders need to explore alternative ways of access such as a bridge /flyover from Long Hill purpose built to cater for modern traffic
