This document has been produced to provide a summary of the site visit on the 12<sup>th</sup> July 2018. Elite Ecology were commissioned by Mr Paul Harris to undertake an endoscopic survey of the structure located at 1A Turnlee Road, Glossop, Derbyshire, SK13 6JS (Central OS Grid Reference: SK 02960 93486). This survey effort is a follow up to the Preliminary Ecological Appraisal undertaken by Elite Ecology on the 13<sup>th</sup> April 2018. This site visit was undertaken by Mr Richard Millington, BSc (Hons), ACIEEM, Natural England Licence Number: 2016-26861-CLS-CLS Bat Survey Level 2.

The survey focussed on the garage and car port that is constructed of a flat felt roof. The structures were deemed to be of low potential to support roosting bats due to gaps along the bargeboards.

The survey on the 12<sup>th</sup> July 2018 found that some of these gaps had cobwebs covering them, thus suggesting bat inactivity. Despite this, some gaps contained no cobwebs and could be in use by crevice dwelling species. These gaps were inspected externally for any bat evidence (e.g. bat droppings), before being internally probed with an endoscope. None of the gaps were found to have any bats present, nor was any anecdotal evidence found. For images in relation to the surveyed structure, please see below.

In summary, the surveyed building at 1A Turnlee Road, Glossop does not contain any roosting bats, with no impacts occurring from the proposed scheme of works.
