If it's the same one as previously, the swept paths didn't look like those for a LRV of 11.6m length which we use as a fall back position unless supported otherwise by the local refuse collection service. i.e. do they wish to enter the site prior to adoption or prefer a bin store adjacent to existing highway from which they collect already?

I shall be setting off for your offices shortly so we can discuss prior to the Burlow Road meeting if you wish.
