Our cottage is situated on the footpath that runs along the reservoir to Kishfield.

We are writing to object to planning application HPK/2018/0426.

~~the~~ Firstly is the issue of access to the proposed site. The road is narrow, steep in parts, has a

very narrow bridge from one approach and a very steep, cobbled slope from the other approach, indeed the stretch of road where the development would be situated is deemed 'Unsuitable for Motors' by our own highways authority.

The footpath that leads along the side of the reservoir to Kishfield is a concessionary footpath, and so technically private.

Todbrook river and all the banks of the reservoir beyond the first weir, and therefore closest to the site, are designated SSSI.

The banks of the reservoir are also protected by English Nature.

Increased footfall or and maintain
