Design and Access Statement

In May 2006 the Government introduced changes to the development control system. The changes were effective from the 10th August 2006.

This is a statement to be read in conjunction with the application for the satellite dish. The dish is required to receive signals from a satellite located above the earth. The dish must have a line of sight with the satellite. This limits the location and position of the dish due to its requirement to have a line of sight.

The satellite dish itself receives signals from dishes that are fixed or mobile and are typically located at sports venues throughout Europe and the USA. It is important that the pictures and information are relayed reliably and without any time delay into the bookmaker.

The dishes are slightly larger than a typical household dish due to the volume of information and the technical information that is supplied with the pictures from the events. The information supplied by the dish must be constant and to ensure uninterrupted service. It is for this reason that the size of the dish is fixed.

In terms of colouration the normal dish is white and the accompanying bracketry is galvanised steel. White is normally considered recessive; however the dish can be painted other British standard colours as can the bracketry if this is considered to be necessary.

The location of the dish to the rear elevation of the building will be screened from view to and from the general area. These types of installations are now accepted as features in street scenes and are part of the street scene and urban context in most towns.

The access to and from the building is not altered or changed and neither are the parking arrangements. The proposal does not change the existing access arrangements.
